



# Summer Term Events

Casual Clothes Days	Friday 28 <sup>th</sup> May & Friday 23 <sup>rd</sup> July	Fundraising for the Memorial Garden – Please send donations into school on the day.
Year 3 Production		This has had to be cancelled. If an opportunity arises to be able to sing in groups, we will try to create a video for parents
Year Group Sports' Days	Week commencing 21 <sup>st</sup> June	Year 6 pupils will design the activities and the PE staff will deliver the sports' days for each year group separately. Spectators won't be able to come along but winners will be announced on our website.
Transition Arrangements	5 <sup>th</sup> – 23 <sup>rd</sup> July	Children will get chances to meet and work with their next teacher whilst staying in their current classroom. The children will be shown where they will be working and where the important parts of the building are before we break for the summer holiday. Our usual information about the next year group will be sent out in the final half term.
Open Evening	Monday 12 <sup>th</sup> July	We will be asking children to select the work that they are most proud of. They will prepare what they are going to tell you about it in school and bring it home to share. Adults at home will be asked to send comments back.
Last year's Y6 presentations	Tuesday 13 <sup>th</sup> July 6pm	Certificates will be posted to all members of the year group that left in July 2020. (Now that we know that it is highly unlikely that we can have a presentation event.) Trophy winners will be invited to an outdoor presentation event with their parents/carers.
Certificate Presentations for each year group	During the last 2 weeks of term.	These will be done in school within year group celebrations. Photographs of those who receive special certificates (and trophies in Year 6) will be posted in a special section of the school website.
End of Year Reports	Friday 16 <sup>th</sup> July	Reports will be in a different format when compared to previous years due to the Covid pandemic.
Memorial Garden Official Opening	Monday 19 <sup>th</sup> July – 5pm	The ex-pupils who proposed the memorial to Jo Charlesworth along with invited guests will officially open the new pond area.
Year 6 Production	Tuesday 20 <sup>th</sup> July	The end of year play will be filmed outdoors and will be available on the school website.
Year 6 Traditional Activities		A separate letter will be sent to Year 6 pupils early in Half Term 6 to give them details of things like Jumper signing, march out etc.
End of Year Parties	Friday 23 <sup>rd</sup> July	Children will be provided with crisps and pop and will play party games in their groups to celebrate the end of the year.
